# Vertical Kitchen Herb Garden: Starter Checklist

## Choose Your Vertical Garden System

Select **one or more** systems based on your space, budget, and style:

- [ ] Wall-Mounted Planter Set
- [] Modular wall planter units
- [] Wall anchors or adhesive hooks
- [] Waterproof wall backing (optional for kitchens)
- [] Tiered Stand / Stacked Rack
- [] Freestanding plant stand (2–5 tiers)
- [] Trays for drainage
- [ ] Hanging Pocket Planters
- [] Fabric hanging planter with multiple pockets
- [] Door/wall hooks or curtain rod
- [] DIY System (Pegboard, Ladder, etc.)
- [] Wooden ladder or pegboard
- [] S-hooks, wire baskets, or recycled containers
- [ ] Mounting hardware or stand

## 🦠 Setup Materials & Tools

## These are **essential for installation and healthy herb growth**:

- [] Measuring tape (to measure wall or area)
- [] Screwdriver/drill (for wall-mount systems)
- [] Adhesive strips or hooks (for renter-friendly options)
- [ ] Labels or garden markers
- [] Water tray or saucers (to catch runoff)
- [] Gloves (for setup and potting)

# **Soil & Drainage Supplies**

Ensure herbs have well-drained and nutrient-rich conditions:

- [] Organic potting mix for containers (with perlite or coco coir)
- [] Pebbles, clay balls, or mesh screen (for drainage layer)
- [] Organic compost (optional)
- [ ] Extra containers or fabric grow bags (if DIYing)

## **Light & Watering Tools**

Provide the right amount of light and hydration:

- [ ] LED grow light (if no natural light)
- [] Timer for grow light (optional)
- [ ] Watering can with narrow spout
- [ ] Moisture meter or finger test reminder
- [] Misting bottle (optional for humidity—not in poor ventilation)

# **Fertilizers & Nutrients**

Keep herbs fed without overdoing it:

• [] Organic liquid fertilizer (fish emulsion, seaweed, etc.)

- [ ] Small measuring cup or dropper for dilution
- [] Schedule/reminder (every 2-3 weeks)

## **Maintenance & Pest Control**

### Maintain herb health and prevent common issues:

- [] Neem oil or natural insect spray
- [ ] Soft cloth or paper towels (to wipe leaves)
- [] Pruning scissors or herb snips
- [] Waste container for trimmings
- [] Notebook or app for tracking care

## MOptional But Helpful Additions

### For an **optimized**, **hassle-free experience**:

- [] Grow chart (light/watering needs of each herb)
- [] Humidity tray or pebble dish
- [] Hanging grow light (for vertical pocket planters)
- [ ] Herb recipe guide or usage chart
- [] Smartphone reminder app for watering/fertilizing

## Storage & Organization

### Keep things tidy and accessible:

- [] Tool basket or bin
- [] Herb care labels
- [ ] Fertilizer storage container
- [ ] Compact shelf or caddy for supplies

### Final Reminder Before You Start

- [] Spot chosen has 4-6 hours of indirect light
- [] Selected herbs match your light conditions
- [] Planters are securely installed
- [ ] Drainage is in place
- [] Herbs are labeled
- [] Initial watering done after planting
- [] Care routine (light, water, food) noted and tracked
